

Orca Takes Home Bald Eagle from Conclave Lodge Well-Represented

Orca Lodge was the proud recipient of the Bald Eagle award at the 2001 Section W-3B conclave, held on September 28-30 at Shasta College in Redding, California. Forty-two arrowmen from the lodge attended the event, which was the highest attendance percentage of the five lodges in the section. Arrowmen also participated in the newlyformed Netami Wulit University, earning several degrees in the colleges of American Indian Studies, Leadership Management, History, Communications, and Advising. In addition, the lodge's Where to Go Camping booklet took third place, and the Orca Spouts was rated the top newsletter in the section. These components garnered the lodge the Bald Eagle award for the first time since 1995, providing fitting recognition to the lodge's presence at the event, as well as its

significant service during many of

the previous section conclaves.

Arrowmen kicked off the conclave's theme of "Climbing new heights to reach greater visio enjoying a movie on night, as w trading and biddin items in the rabilia auctio Saturday, to sessions oc the morning, with


LODGE DINNER IN REDWOOD VALLEY SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 17


