Directions: From Highway 101, take the west bound highway 12 exit (in Santa Rosa). Continue for about 1.4 miles. Take the Stony Point Rd exit, and turn left at Stony Point Rd. Turn right at Sebastopol Rd. In 0.7 mi. turn left at Corporate Center Pkwy. Turn left at Challenger Way. Take the 1st left onto Capricorn Way.

Capricorn Way turns right and becomes Apollo Way. The address is 1030 Apollo Way. The signs on the building will say "North Coast Builders Exchange"

Camp Masonite Navarro site for 2010 Conclave, Work Parties to Prepare Camp



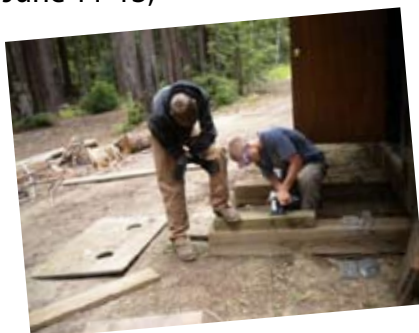
As you may have already heard, the 2010 Section W3N Conclave will be hosted by US, Orca Lodge! This is a very exciting thing since it only happens once every 5 years.

YOU MAY BE AN OVERACTIVE ARROWMAN...

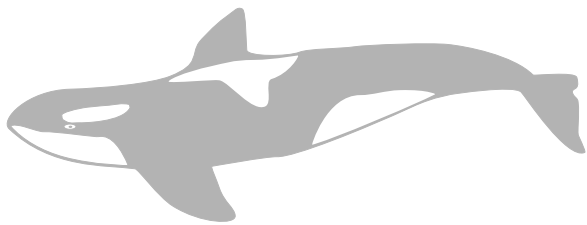
- 1) IF you own underwear with red arrows on them.
